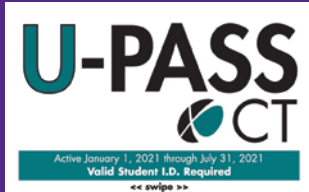

Your Off-Campus Commuting Options

Use Your U-PASS – Ride for **FREE!**

UConn students can ride most transit services in Connecticut for **FREE** using your U-Pass and valid student ID. **More info at CTrides.com/u-pass**



CTtransit provides local daily service in and around Stamford, with many routes servicing UConn Stamford Campus. More info at CTtransit.com.

Bus:

CTtransit **313 – West Broad Street** provides the most service to campus, with service to the Stamford Transportation Center.

CTtransit **311 – Port Chester** provides service to Greenwich and Port Chester.

CTtransit **971 – I-Bus Express** provides service to White Plains (does not accept U-Pass).

CTtransit **341 – Norwalk** provides service to Darien and Norwalk.

Rail:

New Haven Line (Metro-North) provides service to Stamford Station.

Use **New Haven Line (Metro-North)** to travel to New Haven for connections to *CTrail* **Hartford Line** (Hartford, Springfield) and *CTrail* **Shore Line East** (New London). The station is a short walk away, or use *CTtransit* **351** to get there. U-Pass is not valid on **Amtrak** (except Amtrak trains between New Haven and Springfield, excluding the Vermonter). New York City: Connections available using **New Haven Line (Metro-North)** to Grand Central Terminal or **Amtrak** to Penn Station.

Carpool:

Use the *CTrides* app on iOS or Android to find other students, faculty, and staff looking to carpool to and from campus.

Connection to UConn Storrs Campus:

Use **New Haven Line (Metro-North)** to New Haven, and transfer to *CTrail* **Hartford Line** in New Haven to get to Hartford. From Hartford Union Station, *CTtransit* **Express 913 – Hartford – Buckland – Storrs Express** provides service between downtown Hartford and UConn Storrs campus.

Airport Connection:

From Hartford Union Station, take *CTtransit* **30 – Kennedy Road (Bradley Flyer)** to Bradley International Airport 7 days/week. More info at CTtransit.com/services/bradley-flyer.

Use **New Haven Line (Metro-North)** or **Amtrak** service to get to New York City area airports.

NOTE: Routes and service subject to change due to ongoing measures related to COVID-19. Check with transit providers for most up-to-date information.
